74th OREGON LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY--2007 Regular Session

House Bill 3440

Sponsored by Representative ROBLAN; Representatives BOONE, COWAN, KRIEGER, WITT, Senators JOHNSON, KRUSE, VERGER, WHITSETT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Creates Task Force on Near Shore Research. Directs task force to study best way to utilize and conserve Oregon's territorial sea. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to near shore research; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) There is created the Task Force on Near Shore Research. The Governor 4 $\mathbf{5}$ shall appoint members who represent conservationists, angling associations, educators and

6 other groups identified by the Governor.

7 (2) The task force shall study ways of preserving the natural resources found in Oregon's 8 territorial sea and conduct research regarding the territorial sea. The task force shall make

9 recommendations for establishing a Near Shore Research Institute.

10 (3) A majority of the members of the task force constitutes a quorum for the transaction 11 of business.

12(4) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the members of the task force. 13

- 14 (5) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as chairperson.
- (6) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the Governor shall make an appointment to be-15come immediately effective. 16
- 17 (7) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson 18 or of a majority of the members of the task force.

(8) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the task force.

20 (9) The task force shall submit a report, and shall include recommendations for legis-21 lation, to the interim legislative committees on environment and natural resources on or before October 1, 2008. 22

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(10) The State Fish and Wildlife Commission shall provide staff to support the task force.

24 (11) Members of the task force are not entitled to compensation, but may be reimbursed 25for actual and necessary travel expenses incurred by them in the performance of their official duties in the manner and amounts provided for in ORS 292.495. Claims for expenses shall 2627be paid out of funds appropriated to the department for that purpose.

28(12) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist 29 the task force in the performance of its duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating 30 to confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force

- 1 consider necessary to perform their duties.
- 2 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2007 Act is repealed on the date of the convening of the next

3 regular biennial legislative session.

4 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 5 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect 6 July 1, 2007.

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
