SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Expands definition of "police officer" **under vehicle code** to include law enforcement officer employed by county [*law enforcement*] service district for purpose of [*vehicle code*] **law enforcement** services.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to definition of police officer; amending ORS 801.395; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 801.395 is amended to read:

5 801.395. "Police officer" includes a member of the Oregon State Police, a sheriff, a deputy

6 sheriff, [or] a city police officer or a law enforcement officer employed by a service district

7 established under ORS 451.410 to 451.610 for the purpose of law enforcement services.

8 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 9 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect 10 on its passage.
