SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Adds premises open to public in service district to definition of "highway" for purpose of [law enforcement] enforcing traffic offenses, except unlawful sign display.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to service districts; amending ORS 801.305; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 801.305 is amended to read:
5	801.305. (1) "Highway" means every public way, road, street, thoroughfare and place, including
6	bridges, viaducts and other structures within the boundaries of this state, open, used or intended fo
7	use of the general public for vehicles or vehicular traffic as a matter of right.
8	(2) For the purpose of enforcing traffic offenses contained in the Oregon Vehicle Code
9	except for ORS 810.230, "highway" includes premises open to the public that are owned by
10	homeowners association and whose boundaries are contained within a service district estab
11	lished on or before July 1, 2002, under ORS 451.410 to 451.610.
12	SECTION 2. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
13	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect
14	on its passage.
15
