## House Bill 3470

Sponsored by Representative BARNHART; Representatives COWAN, SCHAUFLER

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Prohibits smoking in certain places where children are present.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to smoking in places where children are present; amending ORS 433.835, 433.845 and
3	433.875.
4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> ORS 433.835 is amended to read:
6	433.835. As used in ORS 433.835 to 433.875:
7	(1) "Enclosed area" means all space between a floor and a ceiling that is enclosed on all sides
8	by solid walls or windows, exclusive of doors or passageways, that extend from the floor to the
9	ceiling, including all space therein screened by partitions that do not extend to the ceiling.
10	(2) "Place of employment" means every enclosed area under the control of a public or private
11	employer that employees frequent during the course of employment, including but not limited to
12	work areas, employee lounges, rest rooms, conference rooms, classrooms, cafeterias and hallways.
13	"Place of employment" does not include a private residence unless it is used as a child care facility
14	as defined in ORS 657A.250, a facility providing adult day care as defined in ORS 410.490 or a health
15	care facility as defined in ORS 442.015.
16	(3) "Place where children are present" means a private dwelling, a playground, a park
17	or other recreational facility when children are present.
18	[(3)] (4) "Public place" means any enclosed indoor area open to and frequented by the public,
19	except those public places subject to ORS 441.815, including but not limited to restaurants, as de-
20	fined in ORS 624.010, retail stores, banks, commercial establishments, educational facilities, nursing
21	homes, auditoriums, arenas, meeting rooms and grocery stores.
22	[(4)] (5) "Smoking instrument" means any cigar, cigarette, pipe or other smoking equipment.
23	SECTION 2. ORS 433.845 is amended to read:
24	433.845. (1) [No person shall] A person may not smoke or carry any lighted smoking instrument
25	in:
26	(a) A public place except in areas designated as smoking areas pursuant to ORS 433.850[.]; or
27	(b) A place where children are present.
28	(2) Smoking is prohibited in a room during the time that jurors are required to use the room.
29	<b>SECTION 3.</b> ORS 433.875 is amended to read:
30	433.875. ORS 433.835 to 433.875 and 433.990 (4) shall be cited as the Oregon [Indoor Clean]
