

# House Bill 3477

Sponsored by Representative KOTEK; Representative BOONE

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Imposes civil penalty, not to exceed \$1,500 per day, for violation of certain requirements by business engaged in disposal of bodies, carcasses or parts of dead animals.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to dead animals; amending ORS 601.990.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 601.990 is amended to read:

5 601.990. (1)(a) **A person who violates ORS 601.090 or 601.100 or any rule adopted by the**  
6 **State Department of Agriculture under ORS 601.090 or 601.100 is subject to a civil penalty**  
7 **imposed by the department not to exceed \$1,500 for each day of the violation.**

8 **(b) Civil penalties under this subsection shall be imposed in the manner provided in ORS**  
9 **183.745.**

10 **(2)** Subject to ORS 153.022, violation of any provision of ORS [*601.010 to 601.130*] **601.030,**  
11 **601.040, 601.060 or 601.080** or any rule [*or regulation of the State Department of Agriculture made*]  
12 **adopted by the department** under ORS [*601.010 to 601.130*], **601.030, 601.040, 601.060 or 601.080** is  
13 a Class B violation.

14 [(2)] **(3)** Violation of ORS 601.140 is a Class D violation.
