House Bill 3477

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Imposes civil penalty, not to exceed \$1,500 per day, for violation of certain requirements by business engaged in disposal of bodies, carcasses or parts of dead animals.

Relating to dead animals; amending ORS 601.990.
Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
SECTION 1. ORS 601.990 is amended to read:
601.990. (1)(a) A person who violates ORS 601.090 or 601.100 or any rule adopted by the
State Department of Agriculture under ORS 601.090 or 601.100 is subject to a civil penalty
imposed by the department not to exceed \$1,500 for each day of the violation.
(b) Civil penalties under this subsection shall be imposed in the manner provided in ORS
183.745.
(2) Subject to ORS 153.022, violation of any provision of ORS [601.010 to 601.130] 601.030,
601.040, 601.060 or 601.080 or any rule [or regulation of the State Department of Agriculture made]
adopted by the department under ORS [601.010 to 601.130], 601.030, 601.040, 601.060 or 601.080 is
a Class B violation.
[(2)] (3) Violation of ORS 601.140 is a Class D violation.
