

House Bill 3497

Sponsored by Representative KOTEK

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Human Services to award grants to counties for school-based health centers.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to department for grants.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1 Relating to school-based health centers; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

2 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

3 **SECTION 1. (1) During the 2007-2009 biennium, the Department of Human Services shall**
4 **award grants to counties for school-based health centers.**

5 **(2) The department shall determine:**

6 **(a) The process for awarding the grants;**

7 **(b) The amounts of the grants;**

8 **(c) The criteria for awarding the grants; and**

9 **(d) The purposes for which the grants may be used.**

10 **SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
11 **ated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of**
12 **the General Fund, the amount of \$2 million for the purpose of awarding grants to counties**
13 **for school-based health centers and for administration of the grants.**

14 **SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect**
16 **July 1, 2007.**
