House Bill 3497

Sponsored by Representative KOTEK

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs Department of Human Services to award grants to counties for school-based health centers.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to department for grants.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to school-based health centers; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) During the 2007-2009 biennium, the Department of Human Services shall award grants to counties for school-based health centers.
 - (2) The department shall determine:
 - (a) The process for awarding the grants;
 - (b) The amounts of the grants;
- 9 (c) The criteria for awarding the grants; and
- 10 (d) The purposes for which the grants may be used.
 - SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$2 million for the purpose of awarding grants to counties for school-based health centers and for administration of the grants.
 - SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect July 1, 2007.
