

House Bill 3542

Sponsored by Representative THATCHER (at the request of Carlos Diaz)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Makes modifications of provisions relating to establishment of paternity applicable to proceedings commenced during specified period of time, regardless of when child was born.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to paternity; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 9, chapter 160, Oregon Laws 2005, and the amendments to ORS**
5 **109.070, 109.073, 109.092, 109.124, 109.175 and 109.326 by sections 11 to 16, chapter 160, Oregon**
6 **Laws 2005, apply to proceedings commenced as described in ORS 12.020 after January 1, 2006,**
7 **and before January 2, 2008, regardless of when the child was born.**

8 **SECTION 2. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
9 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect**
10 **on its passage.**
