## House Bill 3564

Sponsored by Representative WITT; Representatives DALLUM, SCHAUFLER, Senators MONROE, STARR (at the request of J. C. Reeves)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires that city with population greater than 140,000 include within its urban growth boundary certain tracts of land that are within corporate limits of city.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to inclusion of land within urban growth boundary of cities with population greater than
3	140,000.
4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 197.298, a city with a population greater than
6	140,000 shall, within six months after the effective date of this 2007 Act, include within its
7	urban growth boundary a tract of land that is within the corporate limits of the city on the
8	effective date of this 2007 Act if the tract is:
9	(a) Capable of being served by public utilities providing electricity, water and sewer ser-
10	vice;
11	(b) Not less than 70 acres nor more than 200 acres in size; and
12	(c) Contiguous to the urban growth boundary.
13	(2) As used in this section:
14	(a) "Tract" has the meaning given that term in ORS 215.010.
15	(b) "Urban growth boundary" has the meaning given that term in ORS 195.060.
16	SECTION 2. An act by a city that includes a tract of land within an urban growth
17	boundary under section 1 of this 2007 Act is not:
18	(1) A land use decision or a limited land use decision reviewable by the Land Use Board
19	of Appeals under ORS 197.805 to 197.855 and 197.860; or
20	(2) Subject to review under ORS 197.610 to 197.650.
