CHAPTER .....

## AN ACT

Relating to financial administration of the State Department of Agriculture; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the State Department of Agriculture and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

- (1) Seed Export Testing..... \$60-140/test
- (2) Annual Pesticide Product  
Registration ..... \$ 160
- (3) Nursery License Surcharge ..... \$ .0002/  
annual sales  
\$ 10 min
- (4) Brand Inspection Time  
and Mileage Fee..... \$ 25

**SECTION 2.** For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the State Department of Agriculture and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

- (1) Commodity Inspection Fee ..... \$ 60 min
- (2) Hundred Weight Inspection Fees  
All Fruits and Vegetables  
except Onions and Potatoes  
20-65 lb net..... \$ .065 per  
container
- (3) Bulk Bins ..... \$ 3.25
- (4) Brine Cherries
  - (a) 15,500 pounds or less..... \$ 43
  - (b) 15,501 pounds to 31,250 pounds . \$ 50
  - (c) 31,251 pounds to 37,500 pounds . \$ 57
  - (d) 37,501 pounds or more ..... \$ 0.18/cwt
- (5) Onions, Potatoes,  
Certified Seed..... \$ 0.12/cwt
- (6) Produce Diversion..... \$ 0.08/cwt
- (7) Tree Nuts

- (a) Filberts in Shell ..... \$ 0.20/cwt
- (b) Walnuts in Shell ..... \$ 0.28/cwt
- (c) Filbert Kernels..... \$ 0.38/cwt
- (d) Shelled Walnuts..... \$ 0.48/cwt
- (8) USDA GHP GAP Audits..... \$ 75/hr
- (9) Minimum Certificate Charge .... \$ 10
- (10) Overtime Charge..... \$ 30/hr
- (11) Export Certificate of Quality  
and Condition FV 184..... \$ 0.02/cwt

**SECTION 3.** This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect July 1, 2007.
