18 are established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limits for the  
19 expenditure of federal funds collected or received by the state agencies listed, for the acqui-  
20 sition of land and the acquisition, planning, constructing, altering, repairing, furnishing and  
21 equipping of buildings and facilities:

1 on June 30, 2013, unless otherwise noted or unless changed by the Legislative Assembly.

2 **“SECTION 4.** The expiration dates of the project approvals and expenditure limitations  
3 authorized by the Legislative Assembly for the following projects are extended to the fol-  
4 lowing dates:

5 **Oregon Military Department**

- 6 (1) **The Dalles Readiness Center .... 30-Jun-08**
- 7 (2) **Ontario Readiness Center..... 31-Oct-10**
- 8 (3) **Medford Armory and**
- 9 **Maintenance Shop..... 31-Dec-07**
- 10 (4) **Baker City Armory ..... 31-Dec-08**

11 **“SECTION 5.** The Legislative Assembly approves the proposal of the Oregon Military  
12 Department, submitted in accordance with ORS 396.515 (4), for the sale of the Ontario Ar-  
13 mory.

14 **“SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
15 expenditures established by section 2, chapter 83, Oregon Laws 2007 (Enrolled Senate Bill  
16 5546), for the six-year period beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for payment of  
17 expenses for the design and renovation of the Eugene State Office Building from fees, mon-  
18 eys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and  
19 federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, is  
20 increased by \$1,116,470.

21 **“SECTION 7.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
22 expenditures established by section 1 (3)(g), chapter 623, Oregon Laws 2003, for the six-year  
23 period beginning July 1, 2003, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses for the  
24 DEQ/Health Laboratory completion of construction from fees, moneys or other revenues,  
25 including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds collected or  
26 received by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, is increased by \$3,700,000.

27 **“SECTION 8.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
28 expenditures established by section 1 (2)(b), chapter 623, Oregon Laws 2003, for the six-year  
29 period beginning July 1, 2003, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses for the Salem  
30 office building construction from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous  
31 Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds collected or received by the Oregon  
32 Department of Aviation, is decreased by \$2,000,000.

33 **“SECTION 9.** This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
34 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect  
35 on its passage.”.
