SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from timber tax funds.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to financial administration of the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following purposes:

(1) **Operations..... \$ 4,641,413**

(2) **Community College Support Fund
for distribution to community
college districts and community
college service districts \$500,000,000**

(3) **Targeted education and workforce
programs..... \$ 2,731,240**

(4) **Debt service on the outstanding
general obligation bonds sold
pursuant to Article XI-G
of the Oregon Constitution..... \$ 3,516,206**

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds, federal funds and those funds described in section 5 of this 2007 Act, collected or received by the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, for the following purposes:

6 **SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
7 \$118,365,405 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for
8 payment of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 4 of this 2007
9 Act collected or received by the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Devel-
10 opment.

11 **SECTION 4.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, expenditures by the Department
12 of Community Colleges and Workforce Development for payments to individuals, organiza-
13 tions or units of government from federal National Emergency Grant funds are not limited.

14 **SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$18,000
15 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of
16 expenses by the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development from
17 moneys received from the Western Oregon Timber Severance Tax Fund and the Eastern
18 Oregon Timber Severance Tax Fund for the Community College Support Fund.

19 **SECTION 6.** This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
20 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect
21 July 1, 2007.

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
