## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Oregon Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists.

Adjusts expenditure limitations for board for biennium ending June 30, 2007. Declares emergency, effective [July 1, 2007] on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to financial administration of the Oregon Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and

3 Therapists; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$637,338

6 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of

7 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-

8 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Board of Li-

9 censed Professional Counselors and Therapists.

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures of the Oregon Board 10 of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists for the payment of expenses of the board 11 from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery 12 13 funds and federal funds, for the biennium ending June 30, 2007, the limitation on expenditures for the Oregon Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists established by 14 section 1, chapter 329, Oregon Laws 2005, as modified by Emergency Board action, is in-15 creased by \$100,000. 16 17 SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect on its passage.
