"SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 39 40 \$45,400,834 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for 41 payment of expenses by the Department of Education from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the department for debt service 42on the outstanding state education lottery bonds issued during the 1997-1999 and 1999-2001 43 44 biennia. "SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 45

\$11,014,255 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Department of Education from lottery moneys allocated from the Oregon Education Fund to the department for debt service on the outstanding state education lottery bonds issued during the 1997-1999 and 1999-2001 biennia.

5 "<u>SECTION 9.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 6 \$2,248,343 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for 7 payment of expenses by the Department of Education from Lottery Bond Fund earnings 8 collected or received by the department for debt service on the outstanding state education 9 lottery bonds issued during the 1997-1999 and 1999-2001 biennia.

"<u>SECTION 10.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, the following expenditures by the
 Department of Education are not limited:

"(1) Moneys from the School Lunch Revolving Account, Education Training Revolving
 Account, Tuition Protection Fund, Common School Fund and Distance Learning Fund; and

"(2) Expenditures for grants-in-aid and purchased services from federal funds received
 by the Department of Education from the United States Department of Agriculture.

16 "<u>SECTION 11.</u> (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is ap-17 propriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the 18 General Fund, the amount of \$25,000,000, to be allocated to the Department of Education for 19 the Oregon prekindergarten program.

"(2) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,084,565, to be allocated to the Department of Education for early intervention services and early childhood special education programs.

"(3) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) or (2) of this section are not allocated by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2008, the moneys remaining on that date become available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

"SECTION 12. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect
July 1, 2007.".
