

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5024

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 27 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the State Forestry Department, for the biennium**  
3 **beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following**  
4 **purposes:**

- 5 (1) Agency administration..... \$ 2,432,736
- 6 (2) Protection from fire..... \$ 23,889,347
- 7 (3) Private forests ..... \$ 11,271,100
- 8 (4) Debt service ..... \$ 2,495,634

9 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**  
10 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limits for payment**  
11 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and in-**  
12 **cluding federal funds from the United States Forest Service for fire protection and for re-**  
13 **search projects, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section,**  
14 **collected or received by the State Forestry Department, for the following purposes:**

- 15 (1) Agency administration..... \$ 21,126,850
- 16 (2) Protection from fire..... \$ 59,614,958
- 17 (3) State-owned forest lands ..... \$ 63,731,249
- 18 (4) Private forests ..... \$ 9,122,495
- 19 (5) Urban forests..... \$ 256,958
- 20 (6) Capital improvement..... \$ 10,402,814
- 21 (7) Debt service ..... \$ 1,790,223
- 22 (8) Forest nursery ..... \$ 4,497,643
- 23 (9) Equipment pool..... \$ 13,798,979
- 24 (10) Facilities maintenance
- 25 and development ..... \$ 3,297,956

26 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**  
27 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limits for payment**  
28 **of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2007 Act col-**  
29 **lected or received by the State Forestry Department for the following purposes:**

- 30 (1) Agency administration..... \$ 774,170
- 31 (2) Protection from fire..... \$ 17,678,581
- 32 (3) State-owned forest lands ..... \$ 145,102
- 33 (4) Private forests ..... \$ 7,101,212
- 34 (5) Urban forests..... \$ 794,654

35 **“SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, expenditures by the State Forestry**

1 Department for the equalization of emergency fire suppression costs from the Oregon Forest  
2 Land Protection Fund, for the purchase of insurance referred to in ORS 477.775 and for fire  
3 cost claims are not limited.

4 **“SECTION 5.** (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is ap-  
5 propriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the  
6 General Fund, the amount of \$4,979,654, to be allocated to the State Forestry Department for  
7 fire protection expenses.

8 **“(2)** If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated  
9 by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2008, the moneys remaining on that date be-  
10 come available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

11 **“SECTION 6.** This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
12 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect  
13 July 1, 2007.”.
