SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Forestry Department for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and certain federal funds, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds. Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts 14 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limits for payment 15 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and including federal funds from the United States Forest Service for fire protection and for re-16 17 search projects, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, 18 collected or received by the State Forestry Department, for the following purposes:
