SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Transportation for certain biennial expenses.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and certain federal funds, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds.

Limits certain biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to financial administration of the Department of Transportation; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> There are appropriated to the Department of Transportation, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following purposes:
