In memoriam: Macon (Mac) Ernest Sumner, Jr., 1940-2007.

2 Whereas Macon Ernest Sumner, Jr., known by his family and friends as "Mac," was born in
3 Sedalia, Missouri, on March 27, 1940; and

4 Whereas Mac Sumner moved with his family to Oregon when Mac was seven years old; and

5 Whereas Mac Sumner's family settled in the Portland area, where Mac attended Benson Tech-
6 nical High School; and

7 Whereas Mac Sumner entered the United States Air Force and proudly served as a jet engine
8 mechanic stationed in Okinawa, including service in Japan and surrounding areas; and

9 Whereas Mac Sumner was honorably discharged from the United States Air Force and began
10 his 33-year career with Safeway; and

11 Whereas Mac and Judy Sumner raised their five children on a small working farm near Molalla;
12 and

13 Whereas Mac Sumner remarried on August 6, 1988, to the former Sandra Riggs and welcomed
14 her two children into his family; and

15 Whereas Mac Sumner, who lived in the Molalla area for 40 years, devoted his later years to
16 public service; and

17 Whereas Mac Sumner served on the Molalla City Council from 1996 to 2004, including two years
18 as mayor; and

19 Whereas Mac Sumner was elected as a Republican to the Oregon House of Representatives from
20 the Eighteenth District on November 2, 2004, and was reelected on November 7, 2006; and

21 Whereas Mac Sumner served honorably as a member of the House of Representatives from
22 January 10, 2005, to December 8, 2006; and

23 Whereas during the 2005 Legislative Session, Mac Sumner served with distinction on the Agri-
24 culture and Natural Resources Committee and the Land Use Committee, where he represented the
25 interests of his constituents very well; and

26 Whereas during the final months of his life, Mac Sumner fought bravely and graciously against

2 Whereas Mac Sumner passed away on May 7, 2007; now, therefore,
