7	became the first team to win four consecutive state baseball championships; and
8	"Whereas the Murrayhill Little League All Stars went undefeated in the Northwest Regional
9	championships, outscoring the state champion teams from Idaho, Alaska, Montana and Wyoming by
10	a combined score of 36 to 6; and

12	Stars became the first Little League team from Oregon since 1958 to earn a berth in the Little
13	League World Series held each summer in Williamsport, Pennsylvania; and
14	"Whereas the Murrayhill Little League All Stars, rallying from a first round loss, earned con-
15	secutive victories over teams representing the Southwest, Midwest and Great Lakes regions, before
16	falling short in the United States title game against the Southeast's representative from Columbus,
17	Georgia; and
18	"Whereas the Murrayhill Little League All Stars ended their dream season by finishing in a
19	third-place tie in the Little League World Series; and
20	"Whereas with the support and sacrifice of their parents and under the direction of Manager
21	Jeff Keller and Coach Ron Pool, the Murrayhill Little League All Stars, composed of Sam Albert,
22	Devon DeJardin, Bryan Domogalla, Jace Fry, Derek Keller, Perry Lampman, Toma Matisoff, Trevor
23	Nix, Austin Perry, Corey Pool, Alec Powell and Miguel Rivera, displayed great defense, hustle, good
24	pitching and timely hitting that gave Oregonians a reason to cheer for them; now, therefore,".
