12	are respectfully requested to work with Oregon when determining adequate yearly progress for the
13	state, its local education agencies and its schools for the 2006-2007 school year if Oregon experi-
14	ences a drop in assessment scores or participation rates to a level that statistically suggests that
15	the disruption was caused by the discontinuation of service by the assessment contractor.
