A-Engrossed House Joint Resolution 12

Ordered by the House February 13 Including House Amendments dated February 13

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Encourages Oregonians to join in celebration of Korean American Day.

1	JOINT RESOLUTION
2	Whereas on January 13, 1903, the first Korean Americans settled in Hawaii; and
3	Whereas Korean Americans, like waves of immigrants to the United States before them, have
4	taken root and thrived in the United States through strong family ties, robust community support
5	and countless hours of hard work; and
6	Whereas the more than 25,000 Korean Americans living in the State of Oregon have made sub
7	stantial contributions to their communities and have invigorated businesses, churches and academic
8	interests in the United States; and
9	Whereas members of the early Korean American community served with distinction in the
10	Armed Forces of the United States during World War I, World War II, the Korean War and the
11	Vietnam War; and
12	Whereas on June 25, 1950, communist North Korea invaded South Korea with approximately
13	135,000 troops, thereby initiating the involvement of approximately 5,720,000 members of the Armed
14	Forces of the United States who served during the Korean War to defeat the spread of communism
15	in Korea and throughout the world; and
16	Whereas casualties of the Armed Forces of the United States during the Korean War included
17	54,246 dead, of whom 33,741 were battle deaths, and 103,284 wounded; and
18	Whereas South Korea is Oregon's second largest trading partner, and our state exported more
19	than \$1.3 billion in goods to South Korea in 2005; and
20	Whereas the United States Congress passed resolutions in 2005 to commemorate Korean Amer
21	ican Day; and
22	Whereas the Centennial Committees of Korean Immigration and Korean Americans have desig
23	nated January 13 of each year as Korean American Day to commemorate the more than 100-year
24	journey of Korean Americans in the United States; and
25	Whereas the State of Oregon has benefited and continues to benefit tremendously from the
26	contributions of Korean immigrants and Korean Americans; now, therefore,
