6	Whereas citizens of many other countries take the opportunity to learn languages and cultures
7	outside of their official, primary language and culture; and
8	Whereas American citizens are the least proficient in foreign languages compared to the res
9	of the world; and
10	Whereas temporarily visiting and living in other countries allows the opportunity to learn lan
11	guages, cultures, customs and traditions; and
12	Whereas knowledge of language, culture, customs and traditions breakdown barriers; and
13	Whereas America could lose economic status if we are complacent in our knowledge of other
14	countries; now, therefore,
15	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
16	That we, the members of the Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly, recognize that there is a need
17	to expand foreign exchange programs for Oregon students to study abroad to learn language and
18	culture.
