

# House Joint Resolution 37

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON REVENUE

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to specify that separate amendment requirement of section 1, Article XVII of Oregon Constitution, does not apply to amendments referred by Legislative Assembly if each amendment relates to subject of taxation.

Refers proposed amendment to people for their approval or rejection at next regular general election.

## JOINT RESOLUTION

**Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:**

**PARAGRAPH 1.** The Constitution of the State of Oregon is amended by creating a new section 1a to be added to and made a part of Article XVII, such section to read:

**SECTION 1a. Notwithstanding section 1 of this Article, the requirement that each amendment to this Constitution be submitted so that each amendment shall be voted on separately does not apply to proposed amendments to this Constitution referred to the people by the Legislative Assembly if each amendment relates to the subject of taxation.**

**PARAGRAPH 2.** The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be submitted to the people for their approval or rejection at the next regular general election held throughout this state.

**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
