

Senate Bill 1021

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS, TRANSPORTATION AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Defines "fuel-efficient vehicle." Decreases vehicle registration fee for fuel-efficient vehicle. Increases registration fee for sport utility vehicle with fuel economy rating below certain amount.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to motor vehicles; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 801.041, 801.042, 803.420 and
3 805.115.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle**
6 **Code.**

7 **SECTION 2. "Fuel-efficient vehicle" means a noncommercial passenger vehicle with a**
8 **fuel economy rating of 40 or more miles per gallon on the highway, as published by the**
9 **United States Department of Energy and the United States Environmental Protection**
10 **Agency.**

11 **SECTION 3. ORS 803.420 is amended to read:**

12 803.420. This section establishes registration fees for vehicles. If there is uncertainty as to the
13 classification of a vehicle for purposes of the payment of registration fees under the vehicle code,
14 the Department of Transportation may classify the vehicle to assure that registration fees for the
15 vehicle are the same as for vehicles the department determines to be comparable. The registration
16 fees for the vehicle shall be those based on the classification determined by the department. Except
17 as otherwise provided in this section, or unless the vehicle is registered quarterly, the fees described
18 in this section are for an entire registration period for the vehicle as described under ORS 803.415.
19 The department shall apportion any fee under this section to reflect the number of quarters regis-
20 tered for a vehicle registered for a quarterly registration period under ORS 803.415. The fees are
21 payable when a vehicle is registered and upon renewal of registration. Except as provided in ORS
22 801.041 (3) and 801.042 (7), the fee shall be increased by any amount established by the governing
23 body of a county or by the governing body of a district, as defined in ORS 801.237 under ORS
24 801.041 or 801.042 as an additional registration fee for the vehicle. The fees for registration of ve-
25 hicles are as follows:

26 (1) Vehicles not otherwise provided for in this section or ORS 821.320, \$27 for each year of the
27 registration period.

28 (2) Mopeds, \$15 for each year of the registration period.

29 (3) Motorcycles, \$15 for each year of the registration period.

30 (4) Government-owned vehicles registered under ORS 805.040, \$3.50.

31 (5) State-owned vehicles registered under ORS 805.045, \$3.50 on registration or renewal.

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

(6) Undercover vehicles registered under ORS 805.060, \$3.50 on registration or renewal.

(7) Antique vehicles registered under ORS 805.010, \$54.

(8) Vehicles of special interest registered under ORS 805.020, \$81.

(9) Electric vehicles and hybrid vehicles that use electricity and another source of motive power, as follows:

(a) The registration fee for an electric or hybrid vehicle not otherwise described in this subsection is \$27 for each year of the registration period.

(b) The registration fee for electric or hybrid vehicles that have two or three wheels is \$27. This paragraph does not apply to electric or hybrid mopeds. Electric or hybrid mopeds are subject to the same registration fee as otherwise provided for mopeds under this section.

(c) The registration fees for the following electric or hybrid vehicles are the same as for comparable nonelectric vehicles described in this section plus 50 percent of such fee:

(A) Motor homes.

(B) Commercial buses.

(C) Vehicles registered as farm vehicles under ORS 805.300.

(D) Vehicles required to establish registration weight under ORS 803.430 or 826.013.

(10) Fuel-efficient vehicles, \$15 for each year of the registration period.

(11)(a) Sport utility vehicle:

(A) \$47 for each year of the registration period if the sport utility vehicle’s fuel economy rating is less than 16 miles per gallon on the highway, as published by the United States Department of Energy and the United States Environmental Protection Agency.

(B) \$37 for each year of the registration period if the sport utility vehicle’s fuel economy rating is 16 or more miles per gallon on the highway and less than 22 miles per gallon on the highway, as published by the United States Department of Energy and the United States Environmental Protection Agency.

(b) For the purposes of this subsection, the Department of Transportation shall define “sport utility vehicle” by rule.

[(10)] **(12)** Motor vehicles required to establish a registration weight under ORS 803.430 or 826.013, and commercial buses as provided in the following chart, based upon the weight submitted in the declaration of weight prepared under ORS 803.435 or 826.015:

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9 (b) The owner of a vehicle described in paragraph (a) of this subsection must certify at the time
10 of initial registration, in a manner determined by the department by rule, that the motor vehicle
11 will be used exclusively to transport manufactured structures or exclusively as described in ORS
12 822.210, 825.015 or 825.017 (14). Registration of a vehicle described in paragraph (a) of this sub-
13 section is invalid if the vehicle is operated in any manner other than that described in the certif-
14 ication under this paragraph.

15 [(12)] (14) Trailers registered under permanent registration, \$10.

16 [(13)] (15) Fixed load vehicles as follows:

17 (a) If a declaration of weight described under ORS 803.435 is submitted establishing the weight
18 of the vehicle at 3,000 pounds or less, \$54.

19 (b) If no declaration of weight is submitted or if the weight of the vehicle is in excess of 3,000
20 pounds, \$75.

21 [(14)] (16) Trailers for hire that are equipped with pneumatic tires made of an elastic material
22 and that are not travel trailers or trailers registered under permanent registration, \$27.

23 [(15)] (17) Trailers registered as part of a fleet under an agreement reached pursuant to ORS
24 802.500, the same as the fee for vehicles of the same type registered under other provisions of the
25 Oregon Vehicle Code.

26 [(16)] (18) Travel trailers, campers and motor homes as follows, based on length as determined
27 under ORS 803.425:

28 (a) For travel trailers or campers that are 6 to 10 feet in length, \$81.

29 (b) For travel trailers or campers over 10 feet in length, \$81 plus \$6.75 a foot for each foot of
30 length over the first 10 feet.

31 (c) For motor homes that are 6 to 10 feet in length, \$126.

32 (d) For motor homes over 10 feet in length, \$126 plus \$7.50 a foot for each foot of length over
33 the first 10 feet.

34 [(17)] (19) Special use trailers as follows, based on length as determined under ORS 803.425:

35 (a) For lengths 6 to 10 feet, \$54.

36 (b) For special use trailers over 10 feet in length, \$54 plus \$3 a foot for each foot of length over
37 the first 10 feet.

38 [(18)] (20) Fees for vehicles with proportional registration under ORS 826.009, or proportioned
39 fleet registration under ORS 826.011, are as provided for vehicles of the same type under this section
40 except that the fees shall be fixed on an apportioned basis as provided under the agreement estab-
41 lished under ORS 826.007.

42 [(19)] (21) For any vehicle that is registered under a quarterly registration period, a minimum
43 of \$15 for each quarter registered plus an additional fee of \$1.

44 [(20)] (22) In addition to any other fees charged for registration of vehicles in fleets under ORS
45 805.120, the department may charge the following fees:

- 1 (a) A \$2 service charge for each vehicle entered into a fleet.
- 2 (b) A \$1 service charge for each vehicle in the fleet at the time of renewal.
- 3 [(21)] **(23)** The registration fee for vehicles with special registration for disabled veterans under
- 4 ORS 805.100 is a fee of \$15.
- 5 [(22)] **(24)** Subject to subsection [(19)] **(21)** of this section, the registration fee for motor vehicles
- 6 registered as farm vehicles under ORS 805.300 is as follows based upon the registration weight given
- 7 in the declaration of weight submitted under ORS 803.435:

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18 [(23)] **(25)** The registration fee for school vehicles registered under ORS 805.050 is \$7.50.

19 [(24)] **(26)** The registration fee for a low-speed vehicle is \$54.

20 [(25)] **(27)** A rental or leasing company, as defined in ORS 221.275, that elects to initially regis-
21 ter a vehicle for an annual or biennial registration period shall pay a fee of \$1 in addition to the
22 vehicle registration fee provided under this section.

23 **SECTION 4. The amendments to ORS 803.420 apply to vehicles purchased on or after the**
24 **effective date of this 2007 Act.**

25 **SECTION 5.** ORS 801.041 is amended to read:

26 801.041. The following apply to the authority granted to counties by ORS 801.040 to establish
27 registration fees for vehicles:

28 (1) An ordinance establishing registration fees under this section must be enacted by the county
29 imposing the registration fee and filed with the Department of Transportation. Any ordinance es-
30 tablishing registration fees that is enacted by the governing body of a county must be submitted to
31 the electors of the county for their approval. The governing body of the county imposing the regis-
32 tration fee shall enter into an intergovernmental agreement under ORS 190.010 with the department
33 by which the department shall collect the registration fees, pay them over to the county and, if
34 necessary, allow the credit or credits described in ORS 803.445 (5). The intergovernmental agree-
35 ment must state the date on which the department shall begin collecting registration fees for the
36 county.

37 (2) The authority granted by this section allows the establishment of registration fees in addition
38 to those described in ORS 803.420. There is no authority under this section to affect registration
39 periods, qualifications, cards, plates, requirements or any other provision relating to vehicle regis-
40 tration under the vehicle code.

41 (3) Except as otherwise provided for in this subsection, when registration fees are imposed under
42 this section, they must be imposed on all vehicle classes. Registration fees as provided under this
43 section may not be imposed on the following:

44 (a) Snowmobiles and Class I all-terrain vehicles.

45 (b) Fixed load vehicles.

1 (c) Vehicles registered under ORS 805.100 to disabled veterans.

11 (L) Travel trailers, campers and motor homes.

12 (4) Any registration fee imposed by a county must be a fixed amount not to exceed, with respect
13 to any vehicle class, the registration fee established under ORS 803.420 (1). For vehicles on which
14 a flat fee is imposed under ORS 803.420, the fee must be a whole dollar amount.

15 (5) Moneys from registration fees established under this section must be paid to the county es-
16 tablishing the registration fees as provided in ORS 802.110. The county ordinance shall provide for
17 payment of at least 40 percent of the money to cities within the county unless a different distrib-
18 ution is agreed to between the county and the cities within the jurisdiction of the county. The
19 moneys shall be used for any purpose for which moneys from registration fees may be used.

20 (6) Two or more counties may act jointly to impose a registration fee under this section. The
21 ordinance of each county acting jointly with another under this subsection must provide for the
22 distribution of moneys collected through a joint registration fee.

23 (7) Before the governing body of a county that overlaps a district can impose a registration fee
24 under this section, it must enter into an intergovernmental agreement under ORS 190.010 with the
25 governing bodies of that district and all counties, other districts and cities with populations of over
26 300,000 that overlap the district. The intergovernmental agreement must state the registration fees
27 and, if necessary, how the revenue from the fees are to be apportioned among the counties and the
28 districts. Before the governing body of a county can enter into such an intergovernmental agree-
29 ment, the county shall consult with the cities in its jurisdiction.

30 **SECTION 6.** ORS 801.042 is amended to read:

31 801.042. The following apply to the authority granted to a district by ORS 801.040 to establish
32 registration fees for vehicles:

33 (1) Before the governing body of a district can impose a registration fee under this section, it
34 must submit the proposal to the electors of the district for their approval and, if the proposal is
35 approved, enter into an intergovernmental agreement under ORS 190.010 with the governing bodies
36 of all counties, other districts and cities with populations of over 300,000 that overlap the district.
37 The intergovernmental agreement must state the registration fees and, if necessary, how the revenue
38 from the fees shall be apportioned among counties and the districts. Before the governing body of
39 a county can enter into such an intergovernmental agreement, the county shall consult with the
40 cities in its jurisdiction.

41 (2) If a district raises revenues from a registration fee for purposes related to highways, roads,
42 streets and roadside rest areas, the governing body of that district shall establish a Regional Ar-
43 terial Fund and shall deposit in the Regional Arterial Fund all such registration fees.

44 (3) Interest received on moneys credited to the Regional Arterial Fund shall accrue to and be-
45 come a part of the Regional Arterial Fund.

1 (4) The Regional Arterial Fund must be administered by the governing body of the district re-
 2 ferred to in subsection (2) of this section and such governing body by ordinance may disburse mon-
 3 eys in the Regional Arterial Fund. Moneys within the Regional Arterial Fund may be disbursed only
 4 for a program of projects recommended by a joint policy advisory committee on transportation
 5 consisting of local officials and state agency representatives designated by the district referred to
 6 in subsection (2) of this section. The projects for which the joint policy advisory committee on
 7 transportation can recommend funding must concern arterials, collectors or other improvements
 8 designated by the joint policy advisory committee on transportation.

9 (5) Ordinances establishing registration fees under this section must be filed with the Depart-
 10 ment of Transportation. The governing body of the district imposing the registration fee shall enter
 11 into an intergovernmental agreement under ORS 190.010 with the department by which the depart-
 12 ment shall collect the registration fees, pay them over to the district and, if necessary, allow the
 13 credit or credits described in ORS 803.445 (5). The intergovernmental agreement must state the date
 14 on which the department shall begin collecting registration fees for the district.

15 (6) The authority granted by this section allows the establishment of registration fees in addition
 16 to those described in ORS 803.420. There is no authority under this section to affect registration

35 (8) Any registration fee imposed by the governing body of a district must be a fixed amount not
 36 to exceed, with respect to any vehicle class, the registration fee established under ORS 803.420 (1).
 37 For vehicles on which a flat fee is imposed under ORS 803.420, the fee must be a whole dollar
 38 amount.

39 **SECTION 7.** ORS 805.115 is amended to read:

40 805.115. (1) In the absence of just cause for refusal, the Department of Transportation shall
 41 provide for registration in a manner consistent with this section for persons who qualify under this
 42 section as active members of the Oregon National Guard. The special registration provisions under
 43 this section are subject to the following:

- 44 (a) The fee to register or renew registration under this section shall be the regular registration
- 45 fee for the vehicle.

1 (b) Any motor vehicle registered under ORS 803.420 (1) and ~~[(16)(c) and (d)]~~ **(18)(c) and (d)** may
2 be registered under this section.

3 (2) A person is eligible for registration under this section if the person is issued a certificate
4 by the Oregon Military Department certifying that the person is an active member of the Oregon
5 National Guard.

6 (3) The department may suspend, revoke or refuse to renew any registration issued under this
7 section if the department determines that the vehicle is owned by a person not qualified for regis-
8 tration under this section or that the vehicle is not eligible for registration under this section.

9 (4) The Oregon Military Department shall notify the Department of Transportation within 30
10 days if a person issued a certificate described in subsection (2) of this section ceases to be an active
11 member of the Oregon National Guard.

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
