

CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS TO B-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1036

June 23

Amended Summary

Restricts local government power to impose construction excise taxes. Authorizes school districts to impose construction taxes. Dedicates revenues from such taxes to capital construction. Authorizes school district to pledge construction taxes to payment of obligations issued to finance or refinance capital improvements.

[Declares emergency, effective on passage.]

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

President Courtney:

Your Conference Committee to whom was referred B-engrossed Senate Bill 1036, having had the same under consideration, respectfully reports it back with the recommendation that the Senate concur in the House amendments dated June 13 and that the bill be amended as follows and re-passed.

1 On page 1 of the printed B-engrossed bill, line 2, delete “declaring an emergency” and insert
2 “prescribing an effective date”.

3 On page 2, delete lines 15 through 20.

4 On page 3, delete lines 34 through 36 and insert:

5 **“SECTION 10. This 2007 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the**
6 **regular session of the Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**
