Senate Bill 1053

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to amend state building code to prohibit installation of synthetic stucco in residential structures.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to synthetic stucco.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "synthetic stucco" means an exterior insulation 5 and finish system, consisting of a foam insulation board inner layer, a polymer and cement 6 base coat middle layer reinforced with glass fiber mesh and a textured finish coat exterior 7 layer, in which the layers bond to prevent the covering from allowing air exchange.

8 (2) The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services shall adopt rules

9 amending the state building code to prohibit the installation of synthetic stucco in residential
10 structures.

11 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services shall 12 complete the adoption of rules under section 1 of this 2007 Act in time for the rules to be-13 come effective on or before April 1, 2008.

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
