

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 118

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, after line 23, insert:

2 “(c) That the declaration will terminate automatically 30 days after the date on which the
3 Governor makes the declaration unless the Governor extends the declaration in accordance with
4 paragraph (d) of this subsection or unless the Governor or the Legislative Assembly terminates the
5 declaration sooner.

6 “(d) That the Governor may extend the declaration for additional 30-day periods by subsequent
7 declarations that the abnormal disruption of the market continues to exist.”.

8 After line 28, insert:

9 “(c) Automatically 30 days after the date on which the Governor makes the declaration unless
10 the Governor or the Legislative Assembly terminates the declaration sooner. The Governor may
11 extend the declaration for subsequent 30-day periods by declaring for each such extension that the
12 abnormal disruption of the market continues to exist. An extension the Governor declares in ac-
13 cordance with this paragraph also terminates 30 days after the date on which the Governor declared
14 the extension unless the Governor declares another extension or unless the Governor or the Legis-
15 lative Assembly terminates the extension sooner.”.

16 On page 2, line 2, delete the period and insert “, a public utility as defined in ORS 757.005
17 (1)(a)(A) or an electric utility as defined in ORS 757.600.”.

18 In line 17, delete “It is an affirmative defense to any claim of a violation of this section” and
19 insert “Evidence described in subsection (3) of this section is not prima facie evidence of a violation
20 of this section if”.

21 In line 18, delete “that”.

22 In line 22, after “(b)” insert “The result of increased internal costs or expenses related to the
23 declaration of an abnormal disruption of the market or”.
