Repeals provision limiting time period youth offender may be transferred to certain mental health institutions.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to youth offenders; repealing ORS 420.500.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 420.500 is repealed.
