SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Lowers minimum age for required school attendance. Takes effect July 1, 2008.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to school attendance; creating new provisions; amending ORS 339.010 and 339.020; and

3 prescribing an effective date.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 339.010 is amended to read:

6 339.010. Except as provided in ORS 339.030, all children between the ages of [7] **6** and 18 years

who have not completed the 12th grade are required to attend regularly a public full-time school
of the school district in which the child resides.

9 SECTION 2. ORS 339.020 is amended to read:

10 339.020. Except as provided in ORS 339.030, every person having control of any child between 11 the ages of [7] **6** and 18 years who has not completed the 12th grade is required to send such child 12 to and maintain such child in regular attendance at a public full-time school during the entire school 13 term.

14 SECTION 3. The amendments to ORS 339.010 and 339.020 by sections 1 and 2 of this 2007

- 15 Act first apply to the 2008-2009 school year.
- 16 <u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2007 Act takes effect on July 1, 2008.
