

**SENATE AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 229**

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, line 28, delete “may at any time” and insert “, upon receipt of a
2 complaint about a licensee and if the board has reasonable cause to doubt the fitness of a licensee
3 to practice psychology, may”.

4 In line 29, delete “, and the” and insert “. The”.

5 In line 33, after “board” delete the rest of the line and lines 34 and 35 and insert “. All docu-
6 ments, records and related information shall be made available to the board for its consideration.
7 All information received by the board related to an assessment of a licensee shall be confidential
8 and may not be disclosed by the board except as required by law.”.
