Senate Bill 25

SUMMARY

Allows jurisdiction to operate photo radar in highway work zone. Sunsets December 31, 2014.

- 2 Relating to photo radar in highway work zone.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle 5 Code.
 - <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) Any jurisdiction may, at their own cost, operate photo radar in a highway work zone, as defined in ORS 811.230.
 - (2) A photo radar system operated under this section may not be used unless a sign is posted announcing that photo radar is in use. The sign posted under this subsection must be all of the following:
 - (a) On the street on which the photo radar unit is being used.
 - (b) Between 100 and 400 yards before the location of the photo radar unit.
 - (3) A jurisdiction that operates a photo radar system under this section shall, once each biennium, conduct a process and outcome evaluation for the purposes of subsection (4) of this section that includes:
 - (a) The effect of the use of the photo radar system on traffic safety;
 - (b) The degree of public acceptance of the use of the photo radar system; and
 - (c) The process of administration of the use of the photo radar system.
 - (4) By March 1 of the year of each regular session of the Legislative Assembly:
 - (a) The Department of Transportation shall provide to the Legislative Assembly an executive summary of the process and outcome evaluations conducted under subsection (3) of this section; and
 - (b) Each jurisdiction that operates a photo radar system under this section shall present to the Legislative Assembly the process and outcome evaluation conducted by the jurisdiction under subsection (3) of this section.
 - SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is repealed on December 31, 2014.
