

# Senate Bill 25

Sponsored by Senator MORSE; Representative BEYER (at the request of Associated General Contractors)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows jurisdiction to operate photo radar in highway work zone.  
Sunsets December 31, 2014.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to photo radar in highway work zone.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle**  
5 **Code.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) Any jurisdiction may, at their own cost, operate photo radar in a highway**  
7 **work zone, as defined in ORS 811.230.**

8 **(2) A photo radar system operated under this section may not be used unless a sign is**  
9 **posted announcing that photo radar is in use. The sign posted under this subsection must**  
10 **be all of the following:**

11 **(a) On the street on which the photo radar unit is being used.**

12 **(b) Between 100 and 400 yards before the location of the photo radar unit.**

13 **(3) A jurisdiction that operates a photo radar system under this section shall, once each**  
14 **biennium, conduct a process and outcome evaluation for the purposes of subsection (4) of**  
15 **this section that includes:**

16 **(a) The effect of the use of the photo radar system on traffic safety;**

17 **(b) The degree of public acceptance of the use of the photo radar system; and**

18 **(c) The process of administration of the use of the photo radar system.**

19 **(4) By March 1 of the year of each regular session of the Legislative Assembly:**

20 **(a) The Department of Transportation shall provide to the Legislative Assembly an**  
21 **executive summary of the process and outcome evaluations conducted under subsection (3)**  
22 **of this section; and**

23 **(b) Each jurisdiction that operates a photo radar system under this section shall present**  
24 **to the Legislative Assembly the process and outcome evaluation conducted by the jurisdic-**  
25 **tion under subsection (3) of this section.**

26 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is repealed on December 31, 2014.**
