Senate Bill 262

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs school district to award high school diploma to student with disability who has completed individualized education program.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to high school diplomas; amending ORS 329.451 and section 3, chapter 827, Oregon Laws 2005; repealing ORS 343.295; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

- **SECTION 1.** ORS 329.451 is amended to read:
- 329.451. (1) In order to receive a high school diploma from a school district, a student must meet the requirements established by the State Board of Education and, while in grades 9 through 12,
- 8 must complete:

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- (a) At least 24 credit hours, as defined by rule of the board;
 - (b) Three years of mathematics; and
- (c) Four years of English.
- (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, a school district may award a diploma to a student who does not meet the requirements of subsection (1)(b) or (c) of this section if the student:
- 14 (a) Has met or exceeded the academic content standards for mathematics or English established 15 by the board; or
 - (b) Displays proficiency in mathematics or English at a level established by the board.
 - (3) Notwithstanding the requirements for a high school diploma established under subsection (1) of this section and by the State Board of Education and school districts under ORS 329.447, a school district shall award a diploma to a student with a disability who has successfully completed an individualized education program, as defined in ORS 343.035. A school district may not indicate on the diploma that the student was educated as part of a special education program.
 - SECTION 2. Section 3, chapter 827, Oregon Laws 2005, is amended to read:
 - **Sec. 3.** (1) The requirements of [section 1 of this 2005 Act] **ORS 329.451** (1) and (2) apply to students who receive a high school diploma from a school district on or after July 1, 2009.
 - (2) The requirements of ORS 329.451 (3) apply to students who receive a high school diploma from a school district on or after July 1, 2007.
 - SECTION 3. ORS 343.295 is repealed.
 - SECTION 4. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect
