2	Relating to sentencing guidelines.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall classify fleeing or attempting
5	to elude a police officer as described in ORS 811.540 (1)(b)(A):
6	(1) As a person felony and crime category 6 of the sentencing guidelines grid of the
7	commission if the person:
8	(a) Is operating the vehicle at more than 20 miles per hour above the posted speed limit;
9	or
10	(b) Has one or more prior convictions under ORS 811.540 (1)(b)(A).
11	(2) As a person felony and crime category 8 of the sentencing guidelines grid of the
12	commission if both conditions in subsection (1) of this section apply.
