

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 314

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 22 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) There is created the Task Force on Cigarette Sales, consisting of seven**  
3 **members appointed as follows:**

4 **“(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint:**

5 **“(A) One member from among members of the Senate.**

6 **“(B) One member of the public with expertise in issues involving the sale or other sup-**  
7 **plying of tobacco products.**

8 **“(b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint:**

9 **“(A) One member from among members of the House of Representatives.**

10 **“(B) Two members of the public with expertise in issues involving the sale or other sup-**  
11 **plying of tobacco products.**

12 **“(c) The Director of the Department of Revenue shall appoint one member representing**  
13 **the Department of Revenue with expertise in tobacco product revenue issues.**

14 **“(d) The Attorney General shall appoint one member representing the Department of**  
15 **Justice with expertise in legal issues pertinent to the tobacco industry.**

16 **“(2) The task force shall study issues that include, but need not be limited to, sales and**  
17 **other means of supplying cigarettes to and by retailers, wholesalers and manufacturers.**

18 **“(3) A majority of the members of the task force constitutes a quorum for the trans-**  
19 **action of business.**

20 **“(4) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the members**  
21 **of the task force.**

22 **“(5) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as chairperson.**

23 **“(6) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority shall make an appoint-**  
24 **ment to become immediately effective.**

25 **“(7) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson**  
26 **or of a majority of the members of the task force.**

27 **“(8) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the task force.**

28 **“(9) The task force shall submit a report, and may include recommendations for legis-**  
29 **lation, to an interim committee related to commerce no later than October 1, 2008.**

30 **“(10) The Department of Justice shall provide staff support to the task force.**

31 **“(11) Members of the task force who are not members of the Legislative Assembly are**  
32 **not entitled to compensation, but may be reimbursed for actual and necessary travel and**  
33 **other expenses incurred by them in the performance of their official duties in the manner**  
34 **and amounts provided for in ORS 292.495. Claims for expenses incurred in performing func-**  
35 **tions of the task force shall be paid out of funds appropriated to the Department of Justice**

1 for that purpose.

2       “(12) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist  
3 the task force in the performance of its duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating  
4 to confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force  
5 consider necessary to perform their duties.

6       “SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2007 Act is repealed on the date of the convening of the  
7 next regular biennial legislative session.

8       “SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
9 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect  
10 on its passage.”.

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
