SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits minor 14 years of age or younger from using tanning device at tanning facility. Imposes civil penalty on tanning facility for violation.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to tanning facilities. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 431.925 to 4 431.955. 5 SECTION 2. (1) A minor 14 years of age or younger may not use a tanning device at a 6 7 tanning facility. 8 (2) A tanning facility that allows a minor 14 years of age or younger to use a tanning

device at its facility is subject to a civil penalty as provided in ORS 431.950.
