

Senate Bill 340

Sponsored by Senators MONNES ANDERSON, MORRISETTE (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits minor 14 years of age or younger from using tanning device at tanning facility. Imposes civil penalty on tanning facility for violation.

2 Relating to tanning facilities.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 431.925 to**
5 **431.955.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) A minor 14 years of age or younger may not use a tanning device at a**
7 **tanning facility.**

8 **(2) A tanning facility that allows a minor 14 years of age or younger to use a tanning**
9 **device at its facility is subject to a civil penalty as provided in ORS 431.950.**
