

Senate Bill 367

Sponsored by Senator COURTNEY (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Education to collect data from school districts on number of minutes of physical education provided to kindergarten through grade 8 students. Directs department to report to Legislative Assembly on data for 2007-2008 school year.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to physical education; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Education shall collect data from school districts on the**
5 **number of minutes of physical education that are provided to kindergarten through grade 8**
6 **students each school day in each public school within the district.**

7 **SECTION 2. Prior to February 1, 2009, the Department of Education shall report to the**
8 **Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly on the data collected under section 1 of this 2007 Act for**
9 **the 2007-2008 school year.**

10 **SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect**
12 **July 1, 2007.**
