

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 384

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

3 **“(a) ‘Administrator’ means a person who is employed as an administrator or is per-**
4 **forming administrative duties, regardless of whether the person is required to have a license,**
5 **and includes but is not limited to superintendents, assistant superintendents and business**
6 **managers.**

7 **“(b) ‘Administrator’ does not include a person who is subject to ORS 342.805 to 342.937.**

8 **“(2) A school district, education service district or public charter school shall:**

9 **“(a) Enter into an employment contract, with each administrator, that has provisions**
10 **that cover the duration of the contract, conditions for contract termination and extension**
11 **and conditions for employee resignation; and**

12 **“(b) Have the current employment contract for each administrator on file in the central**
13 **office of the district or school.**

14 **“(3) Except as provided in subsection (4) of this section, a school district, education ser-**
15 **vice district or public charter school may not enter into an employment contract with an**
16 **administrator that contains provisions that expressly obligate the district or school to com-**
17 **pensate the administrator for work that is not performed.**

18 **“(4) A school district, education service district or public charter school may provide**
19 **health benefits for an administrator who is no longer employed by the district or school until**
20 **the administrator:**

21 **“(a) Reaches 65 years of age; or**

22 **“(b) Finds new employment that provides health benefits.**

23 **“(5) For a period of one year after the termination of the contract between an adminis-**
24 **trator and a school district, education service district or public charter school, the adminis-**
25 **trator may not:**

26 **“(a) Purchase property or surplus property owned by the district or school; or**

27 **“(b) Use property owned by the district or school in a manner other than the manner**
28 **permitted for the general public in a school district or education service district or at a**
29 **public charter school.**

30 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2007 Act applies to contracts entered into on or after the**
31 **effective date of this 2007 Act.**

32 **“SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
33 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect**
34 **on its passage.”.**
