SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires Department of Human Services to report to legislative interim committees regarding children placed in foster care.

2	Relating to Department of Human Services report on foster care placements.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. On or before November 1 of each even-numbered year, the Department of
5	Human Services shall develop and submit a report to the appropriate legislative interim
6	committees dealing with child welfare matters. The report shall cover the prior 24-month
7	period and shall include, but need not be limited to:
8	(1) The number of children in foster care;
9	(2) The number of children that have had more than one foster care placement;
10	(3) The number of placements for each child described in subsection (2) of this section;
11	(4) The percentage of foster children placed apart from siblings;
12	(5) The number of placement changes experienced by foster children;
13	(6) The number and percentage of children placed with relatives; and
14	(7) The department's Status of Children in Oregon's Child Protection System annual re-
15	port.
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
