## Senate Bill 422

Sponsored by Senator WALKER

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Directs county clerk to employ personnel on Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding primary or general election to provide candidates, political committees, political parties or other persons with information listing electors who have cast ballot at primary or general election.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to elections; amending ORS 246.270. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 **SECTION 1.** ORS 246.270 is amended to read: 246.270. (1) On the day of any primary election, general election or special election held 5 throughout the county, the county clerk's office shall remain open for business pertaining to the 6 election from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. of the same day. (2) On the Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding a primary or general election, the 8 county clerk shall employ personnel necessary to provide candidates, political committees, 9 10 political parties or other persons with information listing electors who have cast a ballot at the primary or general election. 11
