

Senate Bill 435

Sponsored by Senator PROZANSKI (at the request of Florence Police Department)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits person that provides telecommunications services from charging Oregon State Police, county sheriff's office, municipal police department or district attorney for tracing calls for purposes of criminal investigations.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to law enforcement.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 759.**

5 **SECTION 2. A person that provides telecommunications services in this state may not**
6 **charge the Oregon State Police, a county sheriff's office, a municipal police department or**
7 **a district attorney for identifying the originating number of an instrument or device from**
8 **which an electronic or wire communication was transmitted if the information requested**
9 **relates to a criminal investigation.**
