On page $\underline{1}$ of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 21 and insert:

2	"SECTION 1. (1) A person commits the crime of aggravated identity theft if:
3	"(a) The person violates ORS 165.800 in 10 or more separate incidents within a 180-day
4	period;
5	"(b) The person violates ORS 165.800 and the person has a previous conviction for ag-
6	gravated identity theft;
7	"(c) The person violates ORS 165.800 and the losses incurred in a single or aggregate
8	transaction are \$10,000 or more within a 180-day period; or
9	"(d) The person violates ORS 165.800 and has in the person's custody, possession or con-
10	trol 10 or more pieces of personal identification from 10 or more different persons.
11	"(2) Aggravated identity theft is a Class B felony.
12	"(3) As used in this section, 'previous conviction' includes:
13	"(a) Convictions occurring before, on or after the effective date of this 2007 Act; and
14	"(b) Convictions entered in any other state or federal court for comparable offenses.
15	"(4) The state shall plead in the accusatory instrument and prove beyond a reasonable
16	doubt, as an element of the offense, the previous conviction for aggravated identity theft.".
