

Senate Bill 477

Sponsored by Senator BEYER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Education to enter into contract with architects for creation of plans for construction of schools. Directs department to make plans available to school districts.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to school planning.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) During the 2007-2009 biennium, the Department of Education shall enter**
5 **into a contract with one or more architects to have plans made for the construction of**
6 **schools. The department shall make the plans available to school districts and may not**
7 **charge the school districts for the plans.**

8 **(2) The department shall contract for two different sets of plans for each size of ele-**
9 **mentary, middle or high school.**

10 **(3) The plans shall be designed:**

11 **(a) For elementary schools to accommodate 250, 375 and 500 students.**

12 **(b) For middle schools to accommodate 350, 550 and 700 students.**

13 **(c) For high schools to accommodate 250, 600 and 1400 students.**
