## HOUSE MINORITY REPORT AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 514

June 22

Speaker Merkley: A minority of your Committee on Revenue, to whom was referred A-engrossed Senate Bill 514, having had the same under consideration, respectfully reports it back with the recommendation that it do pass with the following amendments:
On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 24, delete "and".
After line 24, insert:
"(c) If the land is located within a county with 50,000 or fewer inhabitants according to the
latest federal decennial census, the county has not adopted an ordinance or resolution under section
4a of this 2007 Act; and".
On page 2, line 1, delete "(c)" and insert "(d)".
After line 38, insert:
"SECTION 4a. (1) A county may elect not to participate in the conservation easement
special assessment program under sections 2 to 7 of this 2007 Act if the county has 50,000
or fewer inhabitants according to the latest federal decennial census.
"(2) The county may make the election under this section by filing written notification
of the election with the county assessor before July 1 of the first tax year for which the
election is to be effective.
"(3) An election made under this section shall be valid for all tax years following the year
for which the election is first made, until the election is revoked by the county.
"(4) A county may revoke an election made under this section by filing written notifica-
tion of the revocation with the county assessor before July 1 of the first tax year for which
the revocation is to be effective.
"(5) The written notifications of election and revocation described in this section shall
contain the information and be in the form prescribed by the Department of Revenue by rule.
"(6) An election or revocation made under this section applies to all land within the
county:
"(a) For which an application has been filed under section 4 of this 2007 Act; and
"(b) That qualifies for conservation easement special assessment under section 3 of this
2007 Act.".
