

# Senate Bill 516

Sponsored by Senator ATKINSON

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes persons that are record owners of land in sanitary district to serve as members of governing body of district.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to sanitary districts; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 450.045.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 450.045 is amended to read:

5 450.045. (1) The power and authority given a sanitary district, except as otherwise provided,  
6 shall be exercised by a board of three or five members, according to the number set forth in the  
7 petition for formation.

8 (2) A person is qualified to be a member of the board if the person is an elector of **or owner**  
9 **in** the district.

10 (3) If the first board to be elected has three members:

11 (a) The terms of the candidates receiving the highest and second highest votes expire June 30  
12 next following the second regular district election.

13 (b) The term of the candidate receiving the third highest vote expires June 30 next following the  
14 first regular district election.

15 (4) If the first board to be elected has five members:

16 (a) The terms of the candidates receiving the first, second and third highest votes expire June  
17 30 next following the second regular district election.

18 (b) The term of the candidate receiving the fourth or fifth highest vote expires June 30 next  
19 following the first regular district election.

20 **SECTION 2.** **The amendments to ORS 450.045 by section 1 of this 2007 Act apply to a va-**  
21 **cancy in a district board that occurs on or after the effective date of this 2007 Act.**
