

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 517

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 28.

2 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 14 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. As used in sections 2 and 3 of this 2007 Act:**

4 **“(1) ‘Anabolic steroid’ includes any drug or hormonal substance chemically or**
5 **pharmacologically related to testosterone, all prohormones, including**
6 **dehydroepiandrosterone and all substances listed in the Anabolic Steroid Control Act of 2004.**
7 **‘Anabolic steroid’ does not include estrogens, progestins, corticosteroids and**
8 **mineralocorticoids.**

9 **“(2) ‘Performance-enhancing substance’ means a manufactured product for oral**
10 **ingestion, intranasal application or inhalation containing compounds that:**

11 **“(a) Contain a stimulant, amino acid, hormone precursor, herb or other botanical or any**
12 **other substance other than an essential vitamin or mineral; and**

13 **“(b) Are intended to increase athletic performance, promote muscle growth, induce**
14 **weight loss or increase an individual’s endurance or capacity for exercise.**

15 **“(3) ‘School district employee’ means:**

16 **“(a) An administrator, teacher or other person employed by a school district;**

17 **“(b) A person who volunteers for a school district; and**

18 **“(c) A person who is performing services on behalf of a school district pursuant to a**
19 **contract.**

20 **“SECTION 2. A school district employee may not:**

21 **“(1) Knowingly sell, market or distribute an anabolic steroid or performance-enhancing**
22 **substance to a kindergarten through grade 12 student with whom the employee has contact**
23 **as part of the employee’s school district duties; or**

24 **“(2) Knowingly endorse or suggest the ingestion, intranasal application or inhalation of**
25 **an anabolic steroid or performance-enhancing substance by a kindergarten through grade 12**
26 **student with whom the employee has contact as part of the employee’s school district duties.**

27 **“SECTION 3. (1) The Department of Education shall work in conjunction with voluntary**
28 **organizations approved to administer interscholastic activities under ORS 339.430 to develop**
29 **and implement a program for kindergarten through grade 12 students of evidence-based ed-**
30 **ucation to prevent the use of anabolic steroids and performance-enhancing substances.**

31 **“(2) The department and school districts shall include information on anabolic steroids**
32 **and performance-enhancing substances, including prevention strategies, strength-building**
33 **alternatives and the understanding of health food labels, in health and physical education**
34 **curricula.**

35 **“(3) The department shall ensure that school districts are utilizing programs such as the**

1 **Oregon Health and Science University's Athletes Training and Learning to Avoid Steroids**
2 **(ATLAS) and Athletes Targeting Healthy Exercise and Nutrition Alternatives (ATHENA),**
3 **which have demonstrated effectiveness in reducing anabolic steroid and performance-**
4 **enhancing substance use by high school athletes.**

5 **"(4) The department shall require school district employees who are coaches or athletic**
6 **directors to receive training once every four years on identifying the components of anabolic**
7 **steroid abuse and use and prevention strategies for the use of performance-enhancing sub-**
8 **stances."**

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
