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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for certain biennial expenses.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department. Limits biennial expenditures by department from certain lottery moneys.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Adjusts specified department expenditure limitation for biennium ending June 30, 2007. Declares emergency, effective [July 1, 2007] on passage.

9 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 10 \$1,619,314 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for 11 payment of expenses by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services from lottery 12 moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund for debt 13 service and related costs on outstanding Oregon Public Broadcasting Corporation and 14 Southern Oregon Public Television Corporation bonds issued during the biennium ending 15 June 30, 2007.

16 <u>SECTION 4.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 17 \$3,557,141 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for 18 payment of expenses to support the county fairs in this state from lottery moneys allocated 19 from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Oregon Department 20 of Administrative Services that are deposited in the County Fair Account established under 21 ORS 565.445.

22 <u>SECTION 5.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, the following expenditures by the 23 Oregon Department of Administrative Services are not limited:

(1) Expenditures from the Insurance Fund for acquiring and purchasing insurance or
 reinsurance, allocating and collecting premiums and paying claims for coverage pursuant to
 statutory authority.

(2) Expenditures from the Mass Transit Assistance Account for payments described in
 ORS 291.407 to mass transit districts, transportation districts and service districts.

(3) Expenditures from the Public Employees' Revolving Fund for administration of de pendent care assistance as authorized by ORS 243.221 (2)(c) and expense reimbursement
 plans as authorized by ORS 243.221 (2)(d).

(4) Expenditures from the Public Employees' Revolving Fund for health insurance pre mium subsidies and self-insurance as authorized by ORS 243.167.

<u>SECTION 6.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for the payment of expenses of the department from federal funds, for the biennium ending June 30, 2007, the limitation on expenditures for the Oregon Department of Administrative Services established by section 5, chapter 601, Oregon Laws 2005, as modified by Emergency Board action, is increased by \$35,579.

39 <u>SECTION 7.</u> This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
 40 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect
 41 on its passage.

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
