## Senate Bill 5506

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## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs distribution of moneys from Criminal Fine and Assessment Account. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to financial administration of the Criminal Fine and Assessment Account; and declaring an

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4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding ORS 137.300, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, the

6 Department of Revenue shall distribute the moneys in the Criminal Fine and Assessment

7 Account, reduced by the amount reported by the Department of Justice to the Department

8 of Revenue under ORS 137.300 (6) as specified in sections 3 to 6 of this 2007 Act.

9 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The allocation of the Criminal Fine and Assessment Account made by this
 2007 Act supersedes, replaces and is in lieu of any allocation of such funds in prior years.
